Apples were washed in our basement & stored in an old egg cooler in our garage.

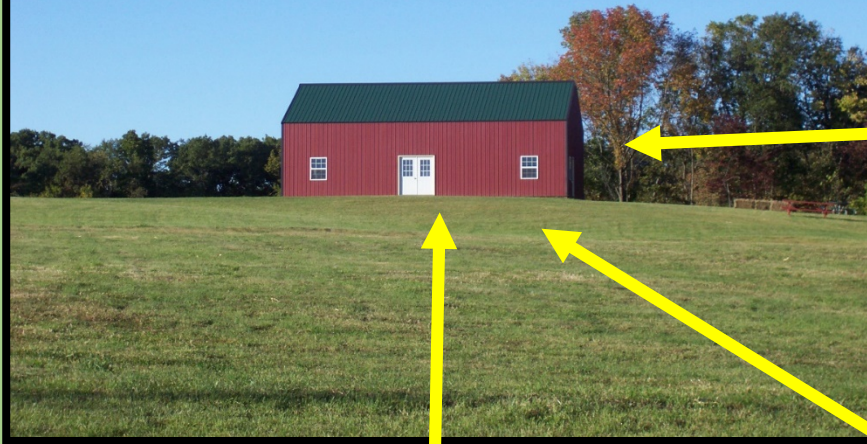


2006 Added 50' x 30' Pole Barn

Still Cramped!

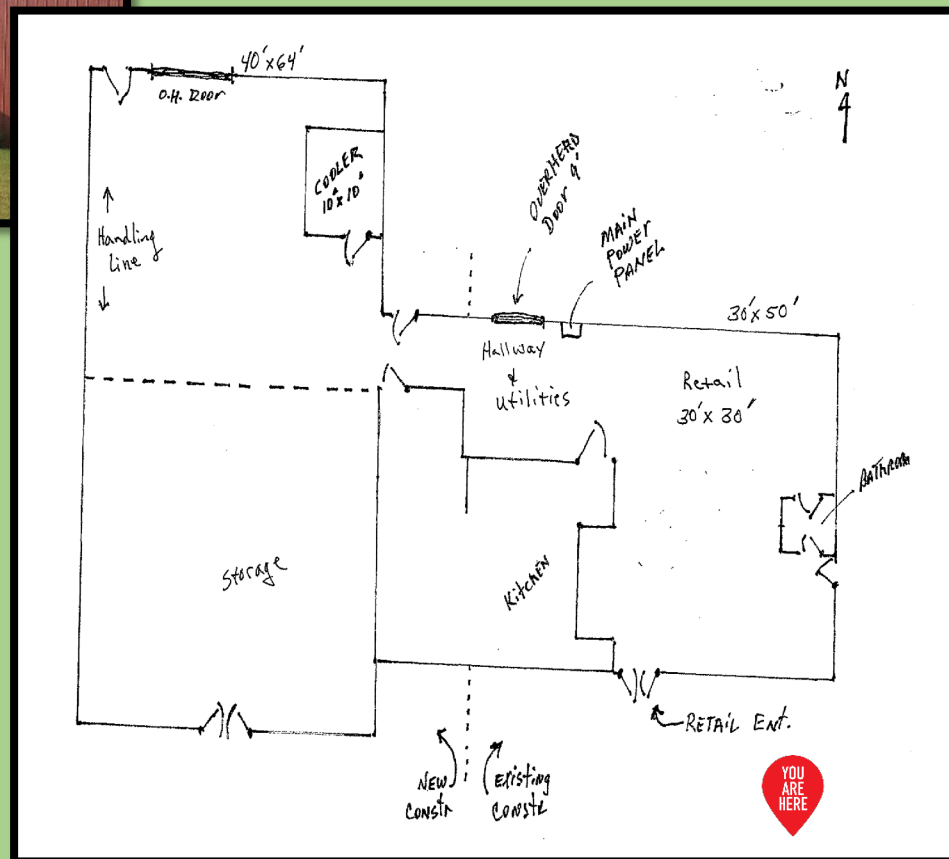


2017 Added a 64' x 40' Pole Building

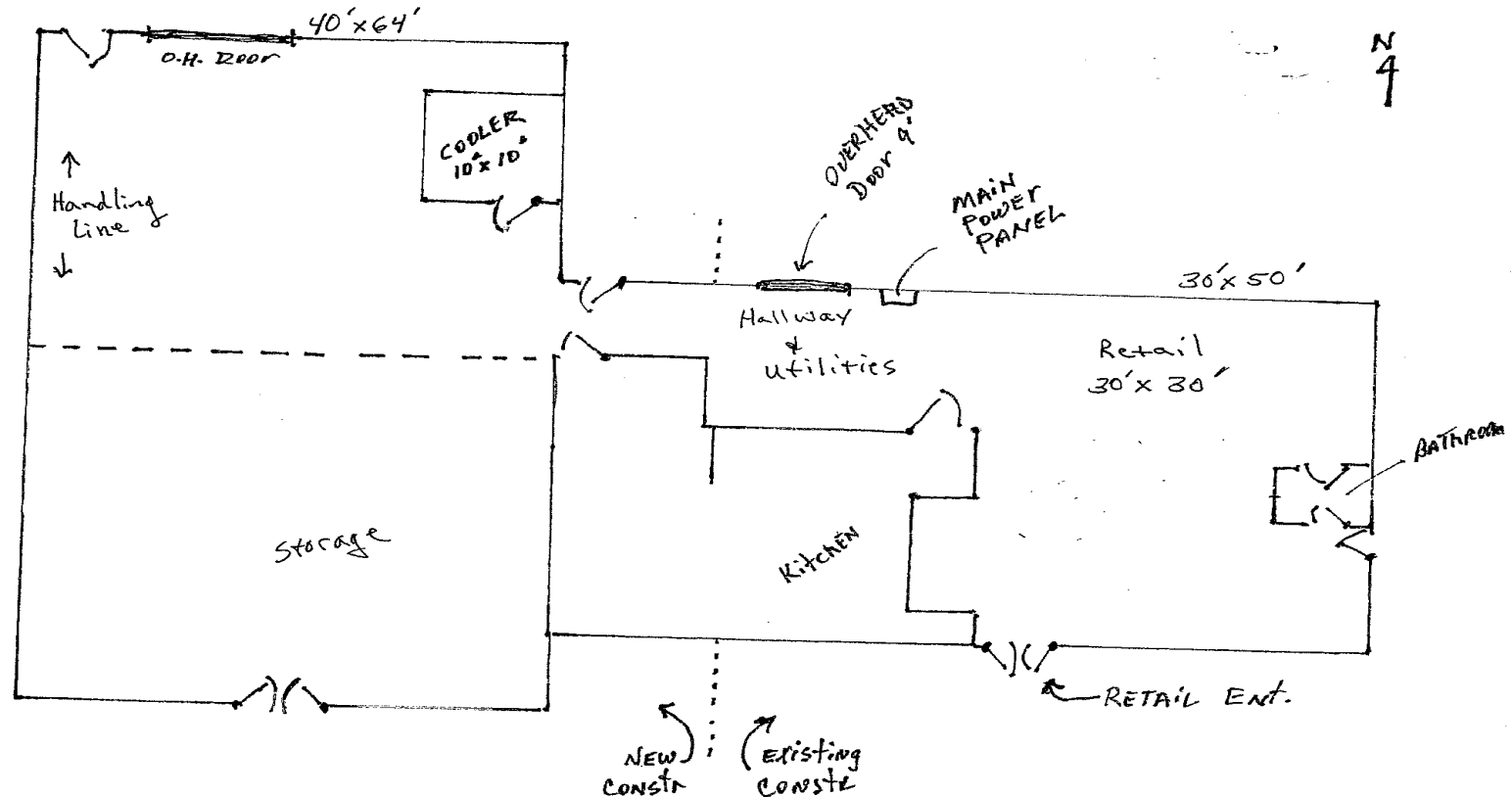


Porch put on in 2019 – added another 400 square feet under roof.

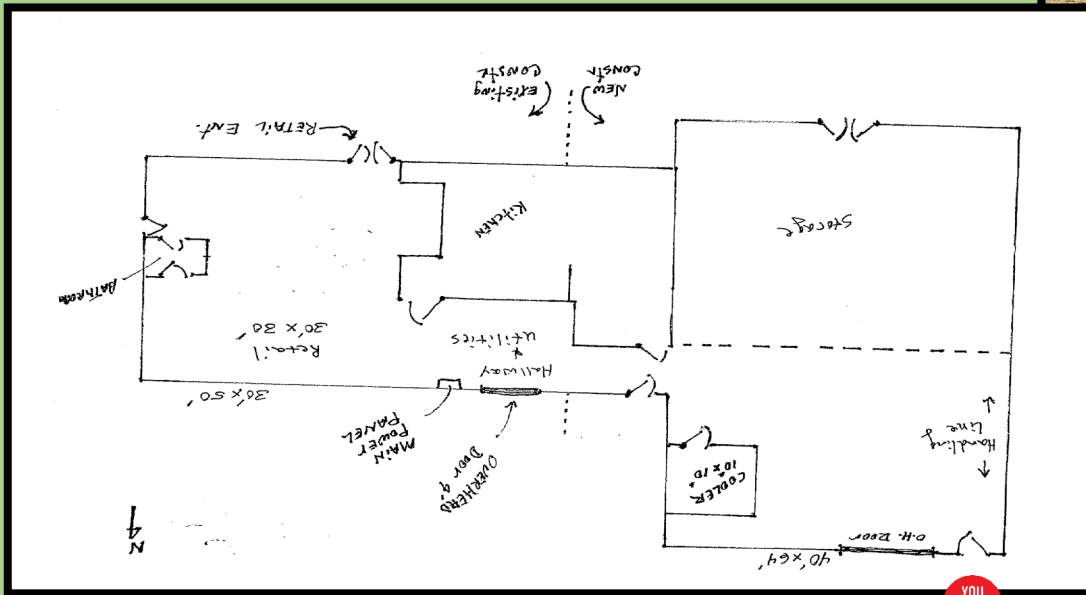


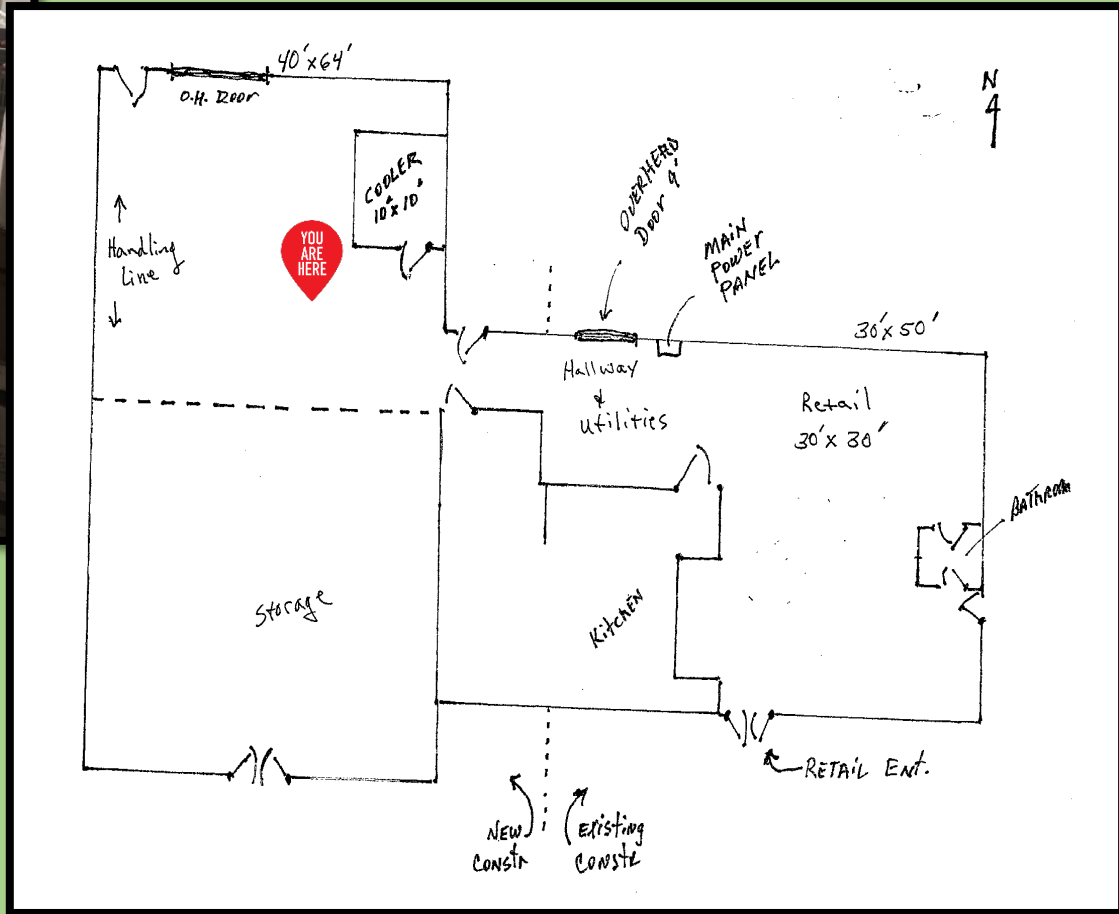


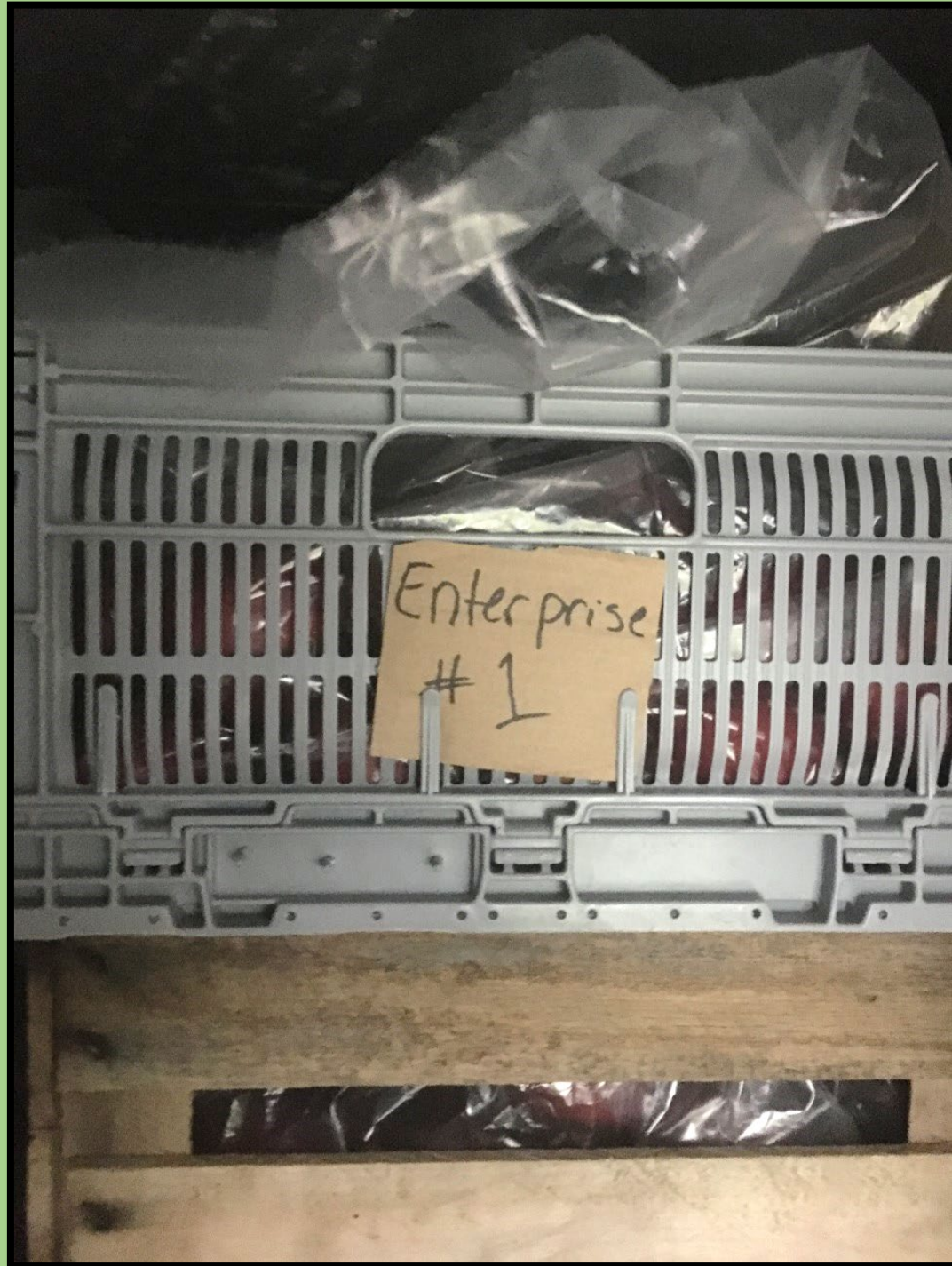
Storage increased from nearly 0 to 1280 sq ft

5% Wholesale







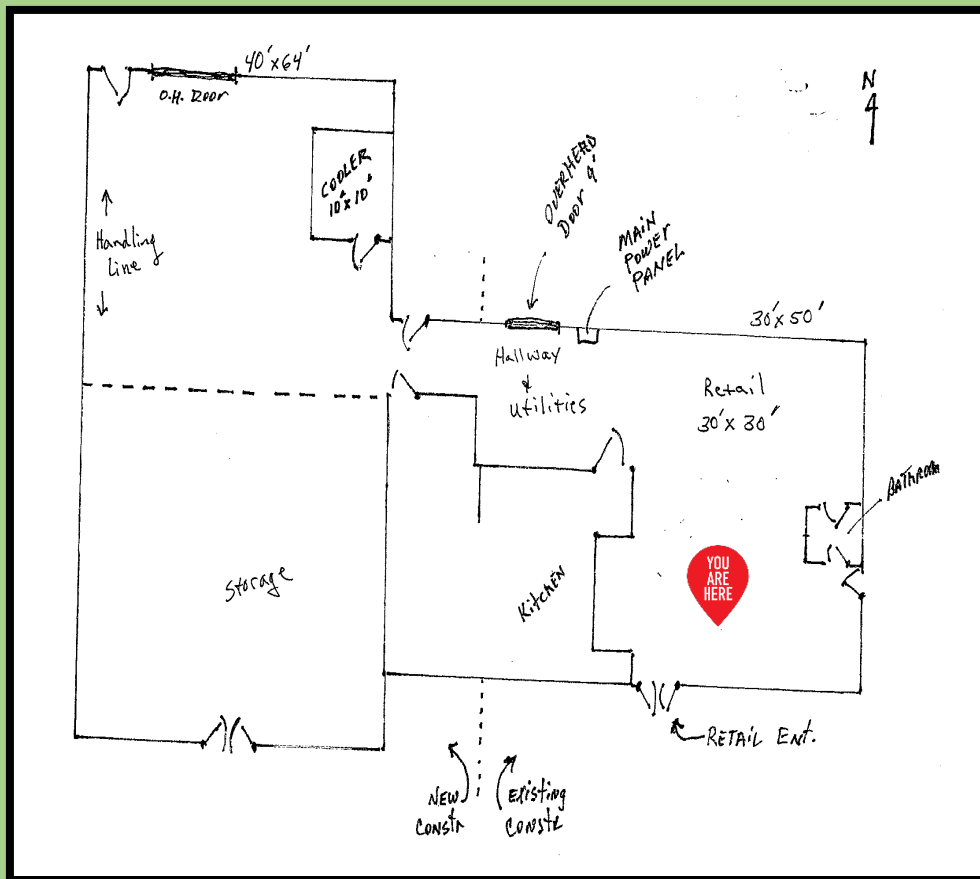
