The USDA Agricultural Marketing Service established the Local Food Purchase Assistance Cooperative Agreement Program (LFPA).

The LFPA program is part of the "Build Back Better" initiative, authorized by the American Rescue Plan.



Goals of the LFPA



Three Overarching Goals



Provide an opportunity for States and Tribal Governments to **strengthen their local and regional food system.**



Help to support local and socially disadvantaged farmers/producers through building and expanding economic opportunities.



Establish, **strengthen**, and **broaden partnerships** with producers and the food distribution community, local food networks, and non-profitsdistributing fresh and nutritious foods in rural, remote, or **underserved communities**.





Pricing Guidance

This Pricing Guidance serves as guidelines on pricing of products purchased through the lowa LFPA and lowa LFP programs to document a fair price for producers while maximizing the amount of food that can be distributed to food insecure households. The price ranges are generous to accommodate a wide range of products and producers, yet this is a competitive program. It is expected that producers will offer products based on their regular wholesale or farmers market pricing. All products purchased through these programs should fall within the price ranges listed.

Steps to Register

> Apply Online

- Click "Register" button on LFPA website
- Register by completing survey
 - ~15 minutes
 - Have W9 and food safety licenses ready
 - Immediate confirmation email that says your application was submitted
- Once registration is reviewed, you will receive an email
 - To let you know you are **registered**
 - Or to let you know you are missing something in order to be approved/ officially registered

Apply by completing the 15 minute survey. Have W9 and food safety licenses ready.




Receive email in less than 2 wks

The email will tell you that you are approved and registered or will let you know you are missing something in order to be approved and officially registered.

Steps to Register





➤ Connect

- Connect with a Distributor listed on the website
- Explore sales options through LFPA with a hub, bank or Meskwaki
 - Email, phone call, in person meetings

Phase 1: Sept. - Dec. 2022

- Iowa's LFPA Initial Program Budget
 - ⋟ \$2.7M awarded to IDALS
 - ➤ USDA approved June 2022
- Food Purchase Budget
 - ▶ \$1.8M : Sept 2022- May 2024
- Phase 1: September- December 2022
 - 17 Distributors were eligible to request up to \$50,000 in funding for Phase 1
 - Food Dollars Allocated via IDALS contracts for Phase 1 totalled \$682,010




Image: Iowa Valley RC&D pie chart Iowa LFPA Budget Allocated to IDALS July 2022

Phase 1: Where did it get us?



Producers

- > 205 LFPA-LFS Producers have fully completed the vetting process
- > Money into pockets of producers (valued at \$570,163.10 to date through LFPA)

Community Access Partners

Local food got into the hands of those who need it in innovative + intentional ways

Food System Development

- Established a baseline awareness of the capacity of this emerging piece of the food system in Iowa
- Building upon and expanding social infrastructure to sustain this work beyond current funding streams
- ➤ There is room to grow!

Timeline

Phase 1: September 2022- April 2023

- Distributor and Annual Producer Meetings for 2023
- Some distributors continue to spend Phase I funding

Phase 2: April 2023- May 2024

- > Phase 2 funds available for spending in April
- ➤ Current program funding ends May 2024





Iowa is currently pursuing and will receive additional funding to extend the program to May 2025!

Iowa LFS

- USDA Local Food for Schools
 - ➤ IDALS and IVRCD partnering to administer the grant
- \$2.2M in local food purchases for lowa Schools
 Fall 2022- May 2024
- Same registration process for producers!
 - Reach out to 3 food hub Sponsors
 - Iowa Food Hub
 - Field to Family
 - Farmtable Delivery
 - Includes Organic Greens Processing Pilot
