

The last day of share pick up will be October 12th (13th for Elkhart)

EMAIL is our PRIMARY form of communication with members including weekly share details. You will receive an email every FRIDAY (starting June 9th) and have until SUNDAY at 10pm to make changes, swaps and extras purchases for the upcoming weeks share.

SHARE PICK UP GUIDELINES:

- You are NOT TO TAKE the FARM'S CONTAINER with you....never ever. Please bring a bag to transfer
 the contents of your share into.
- For FARM PICK UP, you will park in the customer parking area and enter the barn to receive your share. Please exit the barn through the Farm Store.
- For ALL OTHER SITES, please respect the business/resident's property and look for a pile of shares!
 There will also likely be some signs to help.
- CONTACT YOUR SITE HOST DIRECTLY for any last minute changes concerning your share pick up. Site host information is emailed to members in a pick up reminder email Thursday mornings.
- If you are sending someone to pick up for you, please make sure they have all the important information about pick up like taking the correct share and site host contact info just in case.


