

Meet Becky Kilburg, USDA's lowa beginning farmer and rancher coordinator



The USDA can help you start or grow your farming operation through a variety of programs and services. Each state has a beginning farmer and rancher coordinator to educate farmers about programs and resources to meet their specific needs. Meet Iowa's USDA beginning farmer and rancher coordinator, Becky Kilburg.

PFI asked Becky: What is a resource all beginning farmers should know about?

Becky: I advise beginning farmers to reach out to their USDA beginning farmer coordinator and their local FSA and NRCS office to set up an in-person meeting. They will explain finance opportunities and have advice specific to your operation. They can also help you enroll in programs to protect your farm during times of disaster, both environmental and financial. Your local NRCS team will work with you to develop a plan. Everyone's farm is unique. The USDA does a great job working to meet every operation's needs. I always advise new farmers and ranchers to network, be involved in your local extension programs, get advice

from your neighboring farmers and attend the "coffee shop" to get the latest news in your area!
