PFI staff hit the road to learn about the diversity of farming in central lowa

Last Tuesday, PFI staff put work on pause and boarded a bus to spend a day learning about diverse approaches to farming with three PFI member farms in central Iowa. The field trip was the capstone to a professional development series exploring the history of Iowa agriculture, its current challenges and opportunities.

The tour started at Uncle G's Farm south of Ogden, where staff learned how **Garin** and **Kristten Buttermore** raise pastured poultry, heritage pigs and a few cows on their small-scale farm. Next, at Iowa Cover Crop's new warehouse south of Jefferson, staff learned how **Bill Frederick and James Holz** are building community connections while getting more cover crops, small grains and conservation on the landscape.

Finally, at Deal's Orchard, also near Jefferson, staff learned how **Jerald and Cindy Deal**, along with sons **Benji and Chris Deal** and their families, have created a unique agritourism destination that integrates apples, pumpkins (pictured above), row crops, sweet corn, hard cider and an on-farm store. The field trip ended with a staff party at the orchard.

Johnson-Su is a method of creating compost from wood chips or leaves in large, passively aerated and watered piles.

Join Alec and Rachel for a lively discussion and tour of their cropping and edge-of-field conservation practices.

Alec and Rachel Amundson operate a 100% cover cropped, no-till corn and soybean farm spanning 2,400 acres in Mitchell County. Since beginning with cover crops in 2018, they have found new rotation options that work for them, including diversified rotations, alternative crops and managing inputs such as variable-rate fertilizer and seed.

Bridgewater Farm is one of Iowa's largest certified organic vegetable farms, with 25 acres in production, four high tunnels operating for the past 10 years and eight more high tunnels newly built in spring 2024. Dale and his crew grow a wide variety of produce, including tomatoes, melons, sweet corn, spinach, peppers, carrots, squash and more.

Dan Bahe and his father, Don, first dabbled in cover crops 10 years ago with rye spread by their local coop on an 80-acre seed corn field. The following year, they bought their own 15-foot drill and some cover crop seed and never looked back, seeding for neighbors in addition to their own acres. Dan took over the operation in 2015 and has gradually grown the business to about 5,000 acres that he seeds today.
