On Nov. 14, PFI staffers Christine Zrostlik and Elizabeth Wilhelm, along with



PFI offers a cost-share program for specialty crop farmers seeking to make on-farm food safety improvements. Participants must spend at least \$2,200 on improvements and will receive a \$2,000 reimbursement.

Improvements include installing a cooler or CoolBot system, enclosing a packing area, purchasing protective fencing and more. Review the eligibility requirements and apply.
