Minnesota farmers make way for pheasants using precision conservation

In 2019, **Jerry and Nancy Ackermann** began restoring a 3.4-acre area on their farm in Lakefield, Minnesota, transforming it back to native prairie. They partnered with Pheasants Forever to help them use **precision conservation** methods to

pinpoint low-yielding acres on the farm that would be better suited for habitat than cash crop production.

In August 2024, the Ackermanns hosted a field day in collaboration with Practical Farmers of Iowa and Pheasants Forever, where they shared their experience with habitat conversion. Since establishing the prairie, Jerry has noticed measurably less erosion and improved soil health in the adjacent fields.
