Irrigation can boost potato yield, depending on rainfall and soil conditions.

In this trial, **Lee Matteson** wanted to find out how much more his potato plants would yield with irrigation – and if that yield boost would be enough to make up for the cost of setting up and using irrigation systems.

While wet weather affected this year's results, Lee plans to repeat the trial to see how irrigation would help in a drier year, and to inform his calculations about the return on investment.


New blog: "Seed Cover Crops While You Combine: Four Steps To Build Your Own Air-Seeding Combine"



Jack Smith, Ted Smith and Nick Smith of Epworth, Iowa, seed cereal rye into corn stalks for extra cattle forage. Wanting to save time and resources, they built a combine air seeder. With this cover crop seeding method, the farmers were able to seed cereal rye from the combine while harvesting their corn crop.
