After learning about Practical Farmers' beneficial insects cost-share program at the 2024 Annual Conference, **Tricia Engelbrecht** applied and was accepted into the program.

Tricia raises flowers at Engelbrecht Farm near Waverly, Iowa, and says she wanted to sign up to help increase the food and habitat supply for native beneficial insects in her area. Tricia also aims to use beneficial bugs to mitigate pest pressure in two high tunnels she uses as part of her suite of growing methods.


For farmer **Kevin Prevo** of Bloomfield, Iowa, extending the grazing season makes economic and ecological sense.
