Meet Sandro Lopes, a beginning farmer and owner of Naterra Farm **Sandro Lopes,** owner and operator of Nattera Farm, in David City, Nebraska, farms with his wife **Michelle Lopes** and their four children. Sandro follows a rainforest food systems model based on permaculture principles and agricultural practices used by his indigenous ancestors in Brazil. With guidance from his mother, he is putting this generational knowledge to work to feed his community.

"My mother is María Mont Serrat, a woman whose name carries the strength of generations who have worked the land with their own hands and the wisdom of those who have protected life with love and determination," Sandro says.

"The land is calling us! Agriculture is not just a job – it is an act of resistance, love and reconnection with our roots."
