Resources for beekeeping through challenging times

It seems last year was a hard one for bees. The Honey Bee Health Coalition reports that beekeepers nationwide have discovered sudden and significant colony losses over the winter, with average recent losses well over 50%. When these losses are combined with colony losses over the past 12 months, many beekeepers experienced a loss rate of 70% to 100%, according to the coalition.

If your hives are struggling, here are a couple of resources for you:

- <u>Submit emergency assistance claims through the Farm Service Agency for losses by March 3.</u>
- The scientists behind these findings are planning a free webinar to share more information at the beginning of March. <u>Keep an eye on their website</u> <u>for details.</u>
