# **Encourage your schools to Choose Iowa**



Up to \$70,000 is available to public and private K-12 schools to source local foods through a new grant program.

The Choose lowa Food Purchasing Pilot Program for Schools enables schools to apply for \$1,000 per school building in the district. Schools must provide at least a 1:1 financial match. Applications are due at noon on April 7, 2025.

### Enroll in the Iowa Valley RC&D's no-till cost-share



Iowa Valley RC&D's 2025 no-till costshare program application is open now.

Like any new practice, using no-till for vegetable production has a learning curve with potentially reduced productivity.

To help with the financial risk, Iowa Valley RC&D is offering up to a \$500 cost-share to 10 Iowa vegetable growers to trial a no-till practice on their farm. **Apply by April 1, 2025.** 

Is the USDA's Value-Added Producer Grant right for you?



The Value-Added Producer Grant program helps fund agricultural producers' value-added activities to generate new products, create and expand marketing opportunities and increase producer income.

There is approximately \$30 million in total available funding. Maximum grant amounts are \$75,000 for planning grants and \$250,000 for working capital grants.
