### Directions to CEEE:

From US 20: Take Hudson Rd north to University Ave; turn right on University Ave, and then right at the first light (Campus Street). Park in the second parking lot on the right (gravel). The Center for Energy & Environmental Education is to the SE of the lot.

### Directions to West Wind Farm:

From the UNI campus: Go west on University Ave for about 2 miles. Turn right (north) onto Union Road. The site will be on the left (west side of Union Road) just after you cross the small bridge.
